## 12u, 14u & 18u Format:

- Yellow ball
- Matches will be the best of 2 short sets to 4 games with No-Ad Scoring and a 10-point match tie break in lieu of the 3<sup>rd</sup> set.
  - o A 7-point tie-break is played at 3-games all in each set (first to 7 points, win by 2).
- No-Ad Scoring The first player to win 4 points wins the game. If the score reaches 40-40 (Deuce), the winner of the next point wins the game. At Deuce, the receiver has the choice of which side to receive.
  - o In singles, the receiver may choose to receive on either the left or right side of the court.
  - o In doubles, the receiving team has a choice of who will receive the deciding point. Players must stay on the same receiving side they have played during the entire set.
  - o In mixed doubles, the server must serve to the side of the opponent of the same gender. For example, a girl serving must serve to the girl on the deciding point.

## 10u Format:

- Orange ball
